Networking with the various public and private schools in the Cave Creek area, we delve into the world of performance and confidence, striving to continually improve our outreach and impact on the lives of adults and children who live here.

## **Participation and Impact**

Desert Foothills Theater productions and activities fill 47 weekends during the year. Our season officially begins July 1st and ends June 31st each year. We spend the months of July and August on organization and development of our programming and space, rehearsals for the show that opens in September, summer camps for kids, for any improvement projects, and planning we want to achieve. We rely on space provided by the Holland Community Center for our rehearsals, as we are always in rehearsal preparation for an opening - whether it be a festival, fundraiser or regular season show.

We are working towards obtaining a theater of our own. Right now we rent space from the Cactus Shadows Fine Arts Center, both the Main Stage and the Black Box, for our performances. We also hold our summer camp at the fine arts center, providing us with enough space for sixty kids and over twenty staff members participating in our summer Musical Theater Camp!

#### We aspire to: INSPIRE, challenge, Educate and enter tain through theater arts in our community

We support this mission to Inspire, Challenge, Educate and Entertain by involving people of all ages, demographics, ethnicities and walks of life, either behind the scenes, in the front of house or on stage.

We also support other community theaters in our area with props, costumes, set pieces, equipment or sometimes with people or maybe they just want a different perspective. A rising tide raises all ships, and we want to be a part of the rise with our continuing support.





Community theater. There, I said it. If you aren't a member or participant in community theater, you probably conjured up images of a grade school performance from your youth. Theater out and about in the community has grown a bit since those days. Now we have actors that devote time and energy to learning their craft. The people you see on stage have auditioned for the directors with many other actors who may have not been cast in this production. They spent weeks rehearsing the movement, the singing, the dancing, then they spent a week getting used to the actual stage they are performing on, the sound effects and the lighting, because during rehearsal, they don't have access to the stage!

While the actors are rehearsing, both at rehearsal and at home on their own, (they have to memorize all of those songs and lines!) the Production Staff is busy designing the set, the furniture, the decor, what the costumes will look like, how the hair for each character will be, what kind of make-up they need to wear, the props they will use, how the lighting will look, how the sound will...welll....sound, when the costume changes are, and what the overall look and feel of the show will be.

In the office, we are busily creating newspaper advertising, mailer cards, brochures, the playbill, getting promotional photos and headshots, coordinating the concessions, raffles and lobby displays, finding and scheduling volunteers to help usher and work backstage, as well as ensuring any obstacle is overcome for the production. We are also busy working on the next production coming up.

We cover just a portion of our expenses with ticket sales, but everything costs money - the rental on the performance space, the royalties for the show, scripts, music, costumes, props, the set, sound, lights, the ads for the newspapers, postage...everything.

#### Costuming: \$800

underwrites costume design and materials, the things that make our actors look amazing on the stage!

#### Set: \$1,000

underwrites materials we need to create the world the actors live in on stage - things like lumber, screws, paint

#### Lighting: \$500

underwrites lighting design, operations, supplies and equipment needed to give light to the show

#### Sound: \$900

underwrites sound design, sound effects creation, operations, batteries, microphone supplies and equipment that help you hear our actors on stage

#### Music: \$1,200

allows us to use live music in in a production (Godspell) or pay for music tracks for a musical

#### Properties: \$600

underwrites props for the show. Chairs, couches, special effects, hand held and set decoration, so the audience feels like they are actually there

#### Rehearsal Space: \$1,200

underwrites the cost of rehearsal space rental. We have six weeks of rehearsal for each show, sometimes multiple shows overlap or there's an event going on, your support helps us rehearse!

underwrites the fun benefits for the cast, such as bottled water, rehearsal snacks, show T-shirts for youth productions and an opening night party
